**Canal Place Scope of Work for Exterior  
Window Painting to the Second and Third Stories of  
The Historic Western MD Railway Station**

The Canal Place Preservation and Development Authority (CPPDA), is soliciting proposals to repaint front exterior windows. Work to include furnishing labor, material and equipment to scrap loose and peeling paint, spot prime and paint exterior of exposed window sashes, window frames and portions of storm windows already painted. Apply wood filler as required at window sills that are severely weathered. Paint to be Sherwin Williams Super Paint. Nine windows at east elevation, and five windows on the north and south elevations of the second floor of the Historic Western Maryland Railway Station (WMRS). Nine windows at east elevation, and five windows on the north and south elevations of the third floor of the Historic WMRS.
